New Scholarship Opportunities

- **Virginia Junior Chamber International Senate Scholarship:** Senior Leaders; must have recommendation letters, transcripts, and a personal statement; materials can be found at www.tinyurl.com/yfjqccf or from Mrs. Webster
 - **All materials must be submitted by January 6, 2009**
- **NHS Scholarship Program:** Must be members of National Honor Society; must be in good standing academically; RHS can send three nominees; go to National Honor Society website for more information, or see Mrs. Webster for additional materials; must write an essay on the following topic:
 - According to Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs after our psychological needs are met (i.e., food, water, shelter, etc.), people identify safety and security needs as a priority. What do you see as a significant threat to individual safety and security in today's society and what can students do to alleviate such problems.
 - All materials must be submitted to Mrs. Webster by **Jan. 11, 2010**
- **The Blanco Foundation Scholarship Program:** Senior Students; must be interested in a career in education or nursing; must plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college; must demonstrate scholastic achievement, community service, and extra-curricular activities; a short essay and two letters of recommendation are required
 - All materials must be submitted by **Feb. 1, 2010**
- **Scholar Athlete Milk Mustache of the Year (SAMMY):** Senior Athletes; must be active in athletics, community, and in good standing academically; 25 student athletes to win \$7,500 in scholarships and a trip to Disney World; can be nominated by an adult or apply yourself; apply at www.bodybymilk.com
 - All materials must be submitted to Mrs. Webster by **March 5, 2010**
- **Moody's Mega Math Challenge:** High School juniors and seniors; internet-based applied math competition that awards scholarship prizes ranging from \$1,000 to \$20,000; must solve an open-ended applied math-modeling problem; go to www.M3Challenge.siam.org or see Mrs. Webster for more information
 - challenge day is either **March 6 or 7**
- **Max Preps Citizen Athlete Scholarship:** Senior Student Athletes; \$2,500 scholarship to five boys and five girls in the country; model citizens in: community service, academics, athletics, and school involvement; go to www.MaxPreps.com/CitizenAthlete or see Mrs. Webster for more details
 - All materials must be submitted **March 12, 2010**

The following scholarships are offered through the Virginia Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association and you must be a student athlete to participate.

- **Claudia Dodson Award:** Senior athletes planning to go to a 2 or 4 year college; \$1500 to one deserving athlete in VA; must be in need of financial assistance and NOT be receiving full athletic financial aid; have a GPA of 3.0; must have earned **four** or more Athletic Varsity Letters; must have achieved a leadership position(s) in school and community activities; must have extensive service to school and community; must provide a maximum of three letters of recommendation; see Mrs. Webster for applications
 - All materials must be submitted to Mrs. Webster by **Jan. 11, 2010**
- **Past President's Scholarship Award:** Senior athletes planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college; \$1500 to one deserving athlete in VA; must be in need of financial assistance and NOT be receiving full athletic financial aid; have a GPA of 3.0; must have earned **one** or more Athletic Varsity Letters; must have achieved a leadership position(s) in school and community activities; must have extensive service to school and community; must provide a maximum of three letters of recommendation; see Mrs. Webster for applications
 - All materials must be submitted to Mrs. Webster by **Jan. 11, 2010**
- **John C. Youngblood Scholarship Award:** Senior athletes planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college; \$1500 to **three** deserving athletes in VA; must be in need of financial assistance and will NOT be receiving full athletic financial aid; must have earned **one** varsity letter; must have participated in a varsity athletic program for a minimum of two years including his/her senior year; must have made a significant contribution to athletics and have the respect of coaches, peers, teachers, and community; must display character, leadership, scholarship (achieve above-average achievement); see Mrs. Webster for applications
